


Philippians 2:14 “Do all things without murmurings and disputings:”

God lists two things He does not want to hear: murmuring and disputing. Both spring from a wrong view or attitude. If we let the perfect work of God change our view or attitude, we will be content and submissive.

Chapter 2 – Two things God does not want to hear.

Verse 14 – We must let the perfect work of God change us (**7 representing the number of perfection**). Then, what He hears from our mouths is pleasing to Him. **(2 things x7 His perfection =14)**



Murmuring and disputing are weeds growing in our garden. The roots may be due to contention or bitterness. Gossip allows the weed seeds from my garden to blow into and infest someone else's garden. What seeds am I planting in the gardens of those around me?
